## LAKEVIEW COTTAGES PROVIDES:

- Bedroom: Queen and/or Double bed with sheets, pillows, one blanket and light weight bedspread
- Kitchen: Full sized refrigerator/freezer, three burner gas cook top (no ovens), dishes, silverware, glassware, cooking utensils, BBQ tools
- Bathroom: Toilet paper, trash bags
- Misc.: Inside heater, barbeques outside, campfire ring, WiFi
- Library: Books, games, puzzles

## YOU MAY WANT TO BRING:

- Bedroom: Comforter or blankets
- Kitchen: Paper towels, dish towels, pot holders, paper napkins, paper plates, **dishwashing liquid**, foil, baggies, charcoal, lighter fluid (dish soap is the most frequently forgotten item)
- Bathroom: Towels, soap, toiletries, facial tissues
- Staples: Potatoes, onions, bread, mustard, mayonnaise, ketchup, salt, spices, peanut butter, jelly, crackers, BBQ sauce, sugar
- Food: Cereal, eggs, tuna, cheese, spaghetti, hamburgers, salad, fruit, veggies, milk, juice, coffee, tea, cold cuts, meats, hot dogs, hot chocolate, S'mores
- Clothing: It can be warm during the day and cool at night. Dressing in layers is best.
- Misc.: Sunscreen, body lotion, sun glasses, flashlight, night light, bug repellent, first aid kit, extra set of car keys, hat, gloves, scarf, jacket, camera, fishing equipment, fishing license, binoculars, water shoes, hiking shoes, medications, throw rugs, extension cords, reading light,

**Remember: Lakeview Cottages were built in 1913 and have been “updated” throughout the years. Electrical service in our rustic setting is not the same as it is at your home. Remember that heat-producing appliances can draw a great deal of electricity. Too many appliances used at once will also draw too much electricity and may result in a “brown out” for you and your neighbors! We suggest you use your vacation at Lakeview Cottages as an opportunity to return to a simpler way of life.**
